



**2011-2016 Florida Engineering Technology (ET) and Related Program Student Enrollment and Completion  
5-Year Trend Study**

FLATE, a National Science Foundation Regional Center of Excellence, annually requests and compiles student enrollment and completion data for the Engineering Technology (ET) and related A.S. and B.S. degrees and college credit certificate (CCC) programs for Florida colleges, and for related technology programs at the secondary and PSAV level. These data, provided by the Florida Department of Education, are reliable but do not include enrollment for undeclared majors or enrollment in duplicate programs (such as certificates under degree programs). College Registrar reporting/cut dates also result in some reported enrollment discrepancies. Minor anomalies may occur as older program titles are collapsed and new program titles are added. This review contains five sections and an appendix with individual ET adopting college performance, and presents a 5-year trend study which includes the 2015-16 FLDOE report year.

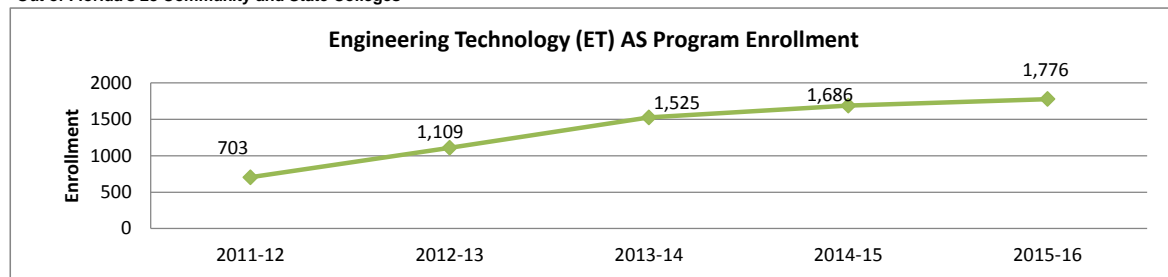

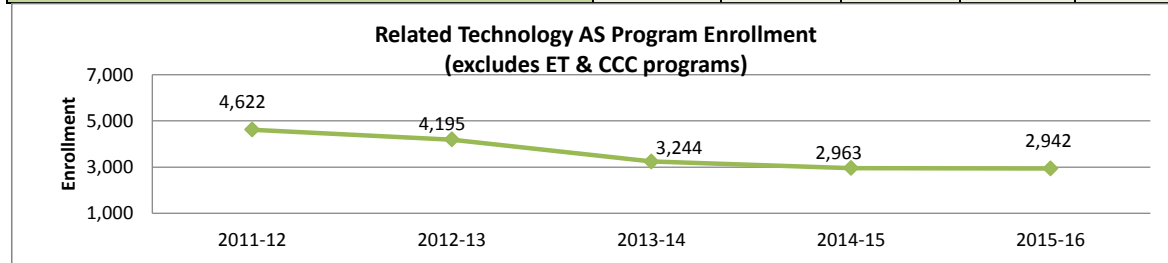

In 2015-16 ET AS Degree program represented 38% of total Florida technology AS degree program enrollment (N=4,718).

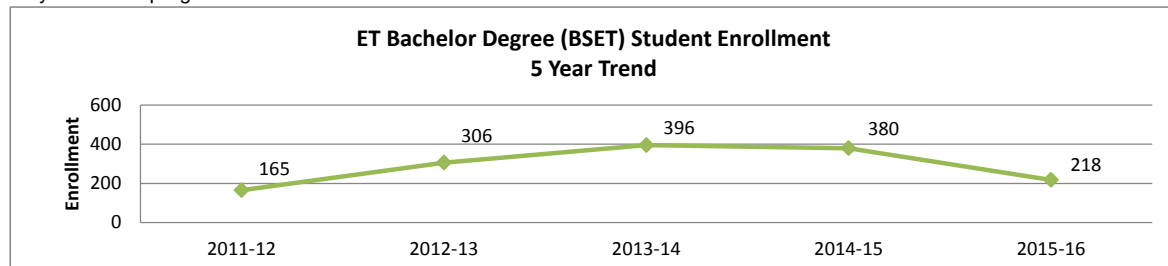
