171 Middle & High Students from Career & Technical Schools in Manatee County To Tour High-Tech Industry Sites for National MFG Day/Month in Florida

Starting October 1, as part of Manufacturing Day in Florida, approximately 171 middle and high school students from approximately 15 middle & high schools will participate in approximately 21 *Made in Florida* industry tours to six high-tech manufacturing sites in <u>Sarasota & Manatee counties</u>, with an Open House and Career Fair scheduled at Manatee Technical College & Suncoast Technical College on Oct. 2 and Oct. 8, respectively. Sarasota County and Manatee County are set to issue countywide proclamations for Manufacturing Day on Oct. 21 and Oct. 22 respectively.
